We require ALL pets to be up to date on their vaccinations during their stay in our hospital for the benefit of them and other pets we have here in our hospital. This is for your pet's safety and well-being. If your pet is due for required vaccinations at time of check in these will be administered and added to your total bill at pick up.

Vaccinations for dogs would include: DHPP, BORDETELLA, RABIES

Vaccinations for cats would include: FVRCP, RABIES

All pets must be free of external parasites (fleas, ticks, ear mites, etc.) Pets with external parasites will be treated at the owner's expense.

If your pet is not on any flea/tick preventative they will be given Nexgard or Revolution when they begin boarding. The cost of Nexgard or Revolution will be added to your total bill which we will collect when you come to pick up your pet. This is for the safety and well-being of your pet & other pets we have here in our hospital.

There will be an additional charge for this service which will be added to your total bill at the time of pick up. If you want your pet to have a bath during their stay, they will not be ready for pick up until 2pm the day of their scheduled pick up.

Puppies and kittens under 16 weeks of age are more susceptible to diseases, infections, and parasites than older dogs or cats. While every effort will be taken to avoid exposure, these pets are at higher risk while boarding.

It is understood that I assume all risks associated with boarding my pet(s) and will not hold Roper Mountain Animal Hospital responsible or liable for any circumstances that may occur from the care, treatment, or safekeeping of my pet(s). In case of illness or injury, I, the undersigned, do hereby give my consent for doctors and staff of Roper Mountain Animal Hospital to treat, prescribe medications, or perform surgery on my pet while they are boarding. All reasonable efforts will be made to contact the owner at the emergency phone number before proceeding. Roper Mountain Animal Hospital is to use all reasonable precautions against illness, injury or escape of my pet (s). Should my pet(s) remain unclaimed after the agreed upon discharge date, I agree that my pet(s) may be considered abandoned. Written notice of abandonment will be mailed to my home address. If my pet(s) remain unclaimed, I agree that I release all claims to my pet(s) and that it may be disposed of as the hospital deems necessary. Abandonment will not release me from payment of services rendered.

All efforts will be made to keep your pets belongings intact, however, understand that as Owner, you assume risks involved with the loss of belongings due to destruction, etc.
